Background History:

Noorvi was found abandoned in a forest in Bihar by villagers, the child was handed over to the concerned authorities. She was admitted to RML Hospital and after keeping her under observation and care in the hospital.

The child was handed over to the police by the hospital after treatment. Noorvi was produced before CWC. By the order of CWC, the little baby was sent to Jeevan Jyoti home for care and protection. Recently, after closure of this organization the child was transferred to Welfare Home for Children on 14.08.23 as the government run home denied admission as they had no space for accommodating the special needs child.

Medical report:

Noorvi is a special needs child; she was diagnosed with Hypoxic Ischemic Encephalopathy (HIE), a serious condition which is caused due to insufficient oxygen reaching brain often around the time of birth. It effects the central nervous system and results in various developmental delays.

Noorvi needs 24 hours support by the caretaker she needs support always while sitting. A significant sign of improving mobility and muscle strength can be seen. Improved head and trunk control can be seen. When she is lying on her tummy or when she is being held, she tries to hold her head up. Due to her neurological issues, she developed at the age of 2 years her growth is affected. Noorvi's vision is also impaired.

She is getting regular therapy by the physiotherapists and improvement can be seen in enhancement of her muscle strength.

Her eating habits are good, she eats whatever meals are prepared for the children.
